## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Acting under the authority of the Ohio Revised Code Sections 119.03, the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology hereby announces a public hearing will be held on Monday, August 17, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board room, 1929 Gateway Circle, Grove City, Ohio.

This is a statement of the agency's intention to promulgate the following rules:

### **Amended Rules**

- **4713-19-01:** Necessity of a permit – this rule is being amended to clarify the intent of the rule.
- **4713-19-02:** Definitions- this rule is being amended to add definitions of "visible light" and "skin typing." Additionally, this rule is being amended to clarify and simplify the meaning and intent of other definitions contained therein.
- **4713-19-03:** Permit fees – this rule is being amended to simplify the rule by deleting original paragraph (A).
- **4713-19-04:** Installation of equipment – this rule is being amended to clarify and simplify the rule by removing words with the same intent and replacing them with the same word or phrases for consistency. Additionally, paragraph (H) has been re-written for clarity.
- **4713-19-05:** Operation of equipment – this rule has been amended to add provisions of ORC 4713.50 concerning procedures a tanning operator must take to reasonably ascertain and individual's age. Additionally, this rule is being amended to clarify and simplify the rule by removing words with the same intent and replacing them with the same word or phrases for consistency.
- **4713-19-06:** Sanitation – this rule is being amended to clarify and simplify the rule by removing words with the same intent and replacing them with the same word or phrases for consistency.

### **New Rules**

- **4713-19-09:** Maintaining records – this rule is being proposed to address the requirements of newly enacted section 4713.50 and 4713-51 of the Ohio Revised Code requiring the development of a consent form for tanning services and the consent form requirements for individuals seeking to use tanning services.

### **Rescinded Rules**

- **4713-19-09:** Maintaining records – this rule is being rescinded and replaced with newly proposed rule 4713-19-09.
